“ In memory of the six members of this Pioneer family who are buried on this site”

Note: British forces came ashore on this meadow during the War of 1812 and badly frightened

the local settlers. No one was harmed but a militia cannon positioned in the meadow was

seized and dumped in the river by the British before they left.

## 46. TYLER – WHITTEN – FREEMAN CEMETERY

Based on his visit to the cemetery, he wrote that there were a number of stones down and bones were in evidence. When members of the cemetery committee initially visited the cemetery in 1994, the area was covered with ground cover, including junipers and numerous trees. The only gravestone was surrounded with wire fencing. ...

In the early 1990's., the property owner began to clean up the area about the Whitten stone and found that the wire fencing surrounded a far larger area than the one stone. It had fallen and was hidden by the heavy ground cover. There was over 50 ft. that circled a large area. When the wire was coiled up and the ground cover removed as well as numerous trees, a number of sunken graves and a wide crescent of head and foot field stones were found . A small broken head stone occupied one of the curved line of graves. It was inscribed :
